5.) Required medical fitness tests and driving aptitude test (PAV):

1. group medical fitness is required, driving aptitude test is needed only after the 5th failed traffic exam.

6.) Conditions for admission to the course and passing the exam: How to enrol in the course:

- in person at the driving school: 1152 Budapest, Szentmihályi road 131.

Personal application:

- identity card, address card, driving licence if you have one;
- a declaration that you have completed primary education and proof of primary education at the first KRESZ exam;
- filling out an application form, a contract; - 16.5 years of age;
- certificate of medical fitness;
- valid residence permit for foreign citizens (6 months);
- payment of the first instalment of tuition fees.

If the student is a under 18 years old, the contract must also be signed by the parent or the legal representative.

Application through web:

If you do not need the signature of your legal representative to start the training, you can apply via web as follows:

- by filling in the personal data;
- by specifying the category of driver's license to be obtained;
- by making the necessary statements;
- after indicating the driving school, the application form is sent to the KAV with a KAÜ (e.g. client account) identification.

If you apply on the website, the driving school will contact you for further administrative purposes. The documents to be signed and the list of documents to be submitted will be sent by post to the postal address provided by the student.

Please take extra care to ensure that you provide accurate information.

(If the personal data you provide do not match the data in your identification documents, the competent authorities may refuse to allow you to take the official exams or to issue your driving licence.)

There is the possibility for personal administration even in case of application through web.

A theoretical exam can be taken after the completion of the theoretical part of the course (at the age of 16 and 3/4 years).

The first theoretical exam must take place within 9 months from the start of the course.

If the student does not pass the theoretical examination within 12 months of the start of the course, he/she can only sit the theoretical examination again after repeating the whole course.

Successful theoretical exam is valid for 2 years.

To be eligible for the practical test, you must be at least 17 years old, have passed the theoretical exam, have completed the mandatory 29 hours/580 km driving practice and have paid the examination fee.

An identity card or passport and, if available, a driver's license must be taken to the exams.

7.) First aid skills:

One of the conditions for obtaining a driving licence - which must be initiated with the competent transport administration authority - is first aid knowledge, which does not require a course, but you must pass an examination. Exemptions from the examination are provided for in Decree 31/1992 NM.

You can do this at any time during the training. U-Drive Driving School does not provide first aid course in English. This is not part of our service, but passed the examination is necessary in order to obtain your driving licence, so we recommend that you contact the Hungarian Red Cross for this, which you can access via the following link: <https://voroskereszt.hu/en/elsosegely/> Scroll down to the "Exam" section. 8.) Theoretical course:

The theoretical knowledge can be acquired by electronic means (e-learning).

The driving school helps students to prepare for the theory test in person or online, if necessary, and checks their knowledge with up-to-date teaching materials.

In the case of e-learning, the course material sent to the student electronically can be used for the following periods:

- theoretical training: 180 days or up to 75 hours;

If necessary, the course can be extended for 30 days or 10 hours.

9.) Practical training:

Together with the practical driving exam 30 hours/580 km, divided as follows:

- Basic education 9 hours
- Driving in the city 14 hours
- Road driving hours
- Night driving 2 hours
- Traffic exam up to 60 minutes

The practical lessons are 50 minutes long, usually two lessons per session.

The practical training takes place in cars with manual or automatic gearbox. You can find out more about the training vehicles on the driving school website.

If the student is late for the driving lesson, this time is counted in the teaching time. If the instructor is late, the delay must be made up. Both the student and the instructor wait 20 minutes for each other. The driving lesson may be cancelled 24 hours in advance (hereinafter referred to as “cancellation”) by either party, provided that the lesson affected by the cancellation will be replaced at the time agreed by the student and the instructor. If the student does not comply with the conditions of the cancellation within the given deadline, the fee for the driving lesson will be forfeited. Missed driving hours cannot be counted in the duration of the practical training.

10.) Fees, payment of fees:

- theoretical training fee: 70.000 HUF;
- the fee for the extension of theoretical training: 30.000 HUF;
- theoretical exam fee: 5.100 HUF;
- practical driving lesson fee: 12.000 HUF; the fee for the extra hours is the same as the fee for the basic lessons;
- Practical driving hours for the “accelerated driving licence” package: 15.000 HUF, fee for extra hours is equal to the fee for basic lessons: 15.000 HUF;
- traffic examination fee: 12.200 HUF

A HUF 3,000 examination administration fee applies to each exam.

The theoretical training fee, the practical driving fee are collectively the Tuition Fees, the theoretical exam fee and the traffic Exam Fees collectively are referred to as Exam Fees.

The student has the option to pay the Tuition Fees and Exam Fees in 5 instalments as follows:

- 1st Instalment at enrolment (theoretical tuition fee)
- 2nd instalment theoretical exam fee
- 3rd instalment 10 hours practice fee,
- 4rd instalment 10 hours practice fee
- 5th Instalment of 10 hours of practice fee + traffic examination fee.

The examination fees paid are accounted for by the training body to the examination board, except in the case of a supplementary computer-based theoretical examination where the student applies for the examination himself/herself.

The student can also register for the computer-based theoretical examination in person at the customer service of any branch of the examination centre after paying the examination fee to the examination centre.

If you have completed the theory course elsewhere, we charge a one-time registration fee of 20.000 Ft.

The supplementary exam fees are the same as the basic exam fee.

Course Fees and Exam Fees can be paid in cash, by credit card or bank transfer at the office.

11.) State contribution:

The state provides a subsidy to pay the fees for the basic traffic knowledge course and the basic traffic knowledge test for the "B" category driving licence.

Foreign nationals defined in points a) and c)–h) of paragraph (1) of Section 39 of Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education are eligible to receive support.

12.) The transfer of the student:

The student has the right to interrupt the training at our school and continue it at another school. At the request of the student, the head of the school will fill in three copies of the training certificate within three days, two of which will be given to the student.

16.) The rights of the student:

- Find out and understand the conditions of the training organisation before starting the training.
- Request and use the service promised in the terms of engagement from the training body.
- Cancel the training, claim back the remaining fees and ask for a certificate of completion.
- Coordinate the date of the practical driving with the competent instructor or the school leader.
- Cancel the agreed practical driving 24 hours in advance.

17.) Obligations of the student:

- Arrive at the training in a fit driving condition, dressed appropriately for the teaching conditions.
- Comply with the school and financial regulations of the training body and to pay the tuition fees in all cases.
- Prepare for the course lessons and follow the instructions of the instructor.
- Appear at the agreed practical driving lesson or cancel it in advance.
- In the case of examinations, pay a "no-show" fee or provide evidence of absence in a credible manner accepted by the authority.
- All individual problems and requests must be reported to the instructor or the head of the school.

18.) The examination centre sends the certificate of successful examination to the competent transport administration authority. After passing the practical test, you will be able to apply for your driving licence at the Office of Government Issued Documents (okmányiroda).
